

**JUNIOR/YOUNG RIDER NATIONAL CCI* TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP
APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

Areas I, II, III, IV, V, and VIII

Midsouth Three-Day Event and Team Challenge

Areas VI, VII, IX, and X

Galway Downs Three-Day Event
November 1-4, 2007

QUALIFYING CONDITIONS:

1. The horse and rider must be qualified to compete in a CCI* according to the FEI Rules for Eventing, 22nd Edition, effective January 2006, Article 506. The FEI rules may be found at www.horsesport.org.
2. The rider must be 14-21 years of age, born between January 1, 1986 and December 31, 1993.
3. The rider must be a US citizen, a current member in good standing (from the date of entry through the end of the Team Championship) of the USEA and USEF, have a current FEI registration and be a current member in good standing of the Area Young Rider program for 2007 for the Area he/she will be representing at the championships.
4. As per FEI Rules for Eventing, 22nd edition, effective 1st January 2006, Article 505.2.1, "a horse may compete in an International Three Day Event ...of a One and Two Star level from the beginning of the calendar year in which he reaches the age of six (6). The horse must also be eligible under FEI rules, registered with the USEA, recorded with the USEF, pursuant to USEF Rule GR812, and in good standing under USEF rules.
5. Horses must have a valid FEI or National Passport or be in possession of identification including an outline diagram and be correctly and verifiably vaccinated according to FEI equine influenza regulations (FEI Veterinary Regulations, 10th Edition, effective June 2006, Annex VII).

TEAM COMPOSITION

1. A team will consist of three or four riders. A rider may not ride more than one horse on a team and may not ride for more than one team.
2. A rider may only compete in one Championship.

HOW TO ENTER

1. Form a team with two or three other Junior/Young Riders from your Area.
2. Notify your Area Young Rider Coordinator of your plan to enter.
3. Complete the 2007 CCI/CIC Entry Form. Be sure to fill in the "Team Name" section. All team names will begin with "Area ?" and the remainder of the name may be submitted by the team members. For example a team name could be "Area VIII Graceful Girls." The USEF, USEA, Area Young Rider Chairman, and/or Organizer reserve the right to not accept inappropriate names.
4. All entries for one team should be sent to the Area Young Rider Coordinator in one envelope. Be sure to include each entry form and appropriate payment for entry, stabling, and other applicable competition fees. All teams are responsible for its own expenses.
5. Should an individual or two individuals not have a team but wish to enter, please submit an entry as outlined above and teams will be put together.
